

AmeriCorps-NCCC Team at Wabeno Town Board July 21st Meeting

At the July 21st bi-monthly meeting of the Wabeno Town Board, representatives from the AmeriCorps-NCCC Team will describe the AmeriCorps program to the board and any interested residents. The AmeriCorps Team has been in Wabeno since June 29th and working on the Barrier Free Boardwalk and Trail and other community projects in Wabeno. The presentation may be of particular interest to young people looking for post high school options this year or in the future. The meeting starts at 6 pm at the Wabeno Town Hall.

AmeriCorps NCCC is a full-time, team-based residential program for men and women age 18-24 whose mission is to strengthen communities and develop leaders through direct, team-based community service in partnerships with non-profits, schools, local, state, federal and tribal governments, and national and state parks. The 22 year old program is drawn from the successful models of the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) of the 1930s and the U.S. military.
